

Resolutions Passed in 3rd All India Conference of AITEEA on 11th June, 2022 at ALTTC Ghaziabad

In the Annual General Meeting of All India Telecom Executive & Engineers Association [AITEEA] held on 11th of June, 2022 at ALTTC Ghaziabad, following resolutions were passed by the AITEEA members present in the meeting:

1. AITEEA demands immediate roll out of 5G enabled 4G equipment on Pan India Basis in All BTS sites without any further delay.
2. AITEEA demands administrative allotment of mid band 5G Spectrums by DoT and its trial viability to be checked and explored by BSNL.
3. AITEEA will continue to raise the issue of 22820/ at all the available platforms including AUAB. AITEEA will consistently follow the review OA against the Judgement in the OA – 3208/2011 case at PCAT New Delhi on pay anomaly issue.
4. AITEEA demands settlement of Standard Pay Scale in the line of FCI without any cascading of further pay scales. AITEEA will continue to fight for Standard Pay scale case at CAT Kolkata.
5. AITEEA demands clearing of All the left out promotions of JTO-2008 batch.
6. AITEEA supports & will consistently pursue all pending promotions among all the cadres (JTO/JAO to DGM/CAO) including Civil & Electrical stream.
7. AITEEA demands & support fast track promotion mechanism for BSNL Executives. All the lateral entry is to be filled by BSNL Executives only and therefore corresponding changes in MSRR is demanded. AITEEA demands for all the external vacancy to be diverted for internal applicants as enormous human resource is there in BSNL itself. AITEEA demands declaration of result of MT Exam conducted for internal applicants.
8. AITEEA supports & will continue to fight against Pay anomaly issue of SRD & GATE JTOs before BSNL Management.

9. AITEEA will consistently pursue Management for clearing all SAB contribution, given that even the partly approved SAB amount is not being deposited by BSNL for more than 18 months.
10. AITEEA supports continuation of BSNL MRS Policy. In addition to the existing BSNLMRS policy, if any Health insurance is proposed by BSNL Management, the premium is to be bear by BSNL Management not by BSNL employee.
11. AITEEA supports fair transfer policy and opposes any arbitrary transfer in any cadre. AITEEA demands for publishing the criteria in settling the OTP cases to ensure transparency.
12. AITEEA demands for fair calculation of employees' strength in all cadres after restructuring in All Circles.
13. AITEEA demands for JTO Cadre to be declared as All India Cadre in the light of the changed scenario after restructuring.
14. AITEEA proposes necessary amendments in compassionate ground appointments [CGA] rules in the changed scenario and demands for existing CGA to be done for all Covid death cases as one time settlement measures.
15. AITEEA opposes any move of DoT/MoC to take over assets of BSNL unilaterally.
16. AITEEA supports 3rd PRC demand of AUAB in anticipation that AUAB will raise its voice for all left out issue of 2nd PRC.
